


14 ESSENTIAL NAPA VALLEY RESTAURANTS

Since its first five decades as Taylor's Automatic Refresher and now a decade as Gott's Roadside, this St. Helena roadside burger shack is truly a valley landmark — and it's the only local restaurant named a James Beard Regional American Classic. The thin patty burgers dripping with Thousand Island–like "secret sauce" always satisfy, especially a wine and beer selection that's way above average for counter service.
